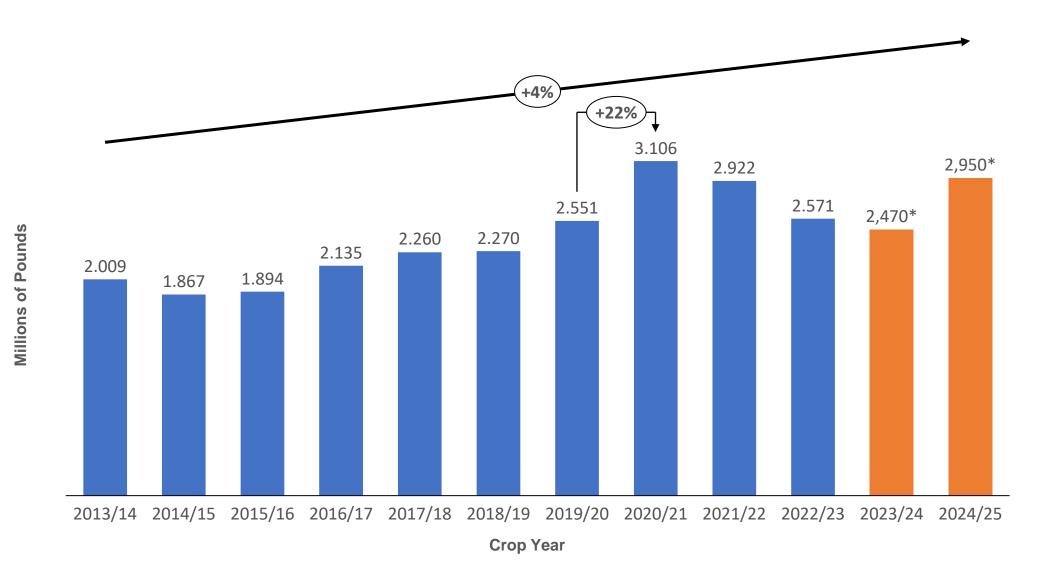

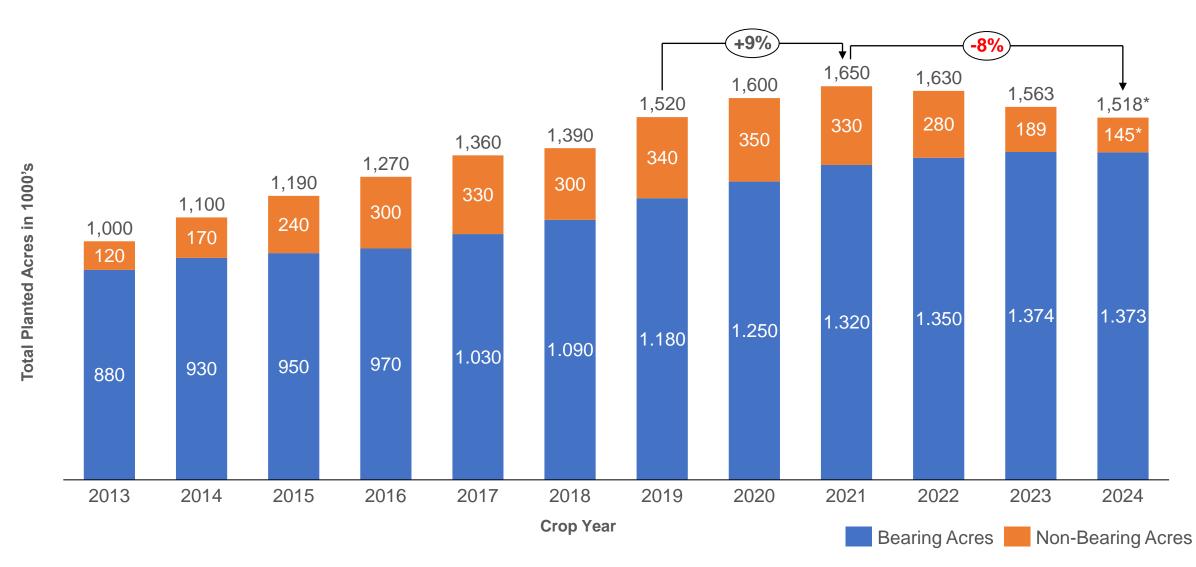

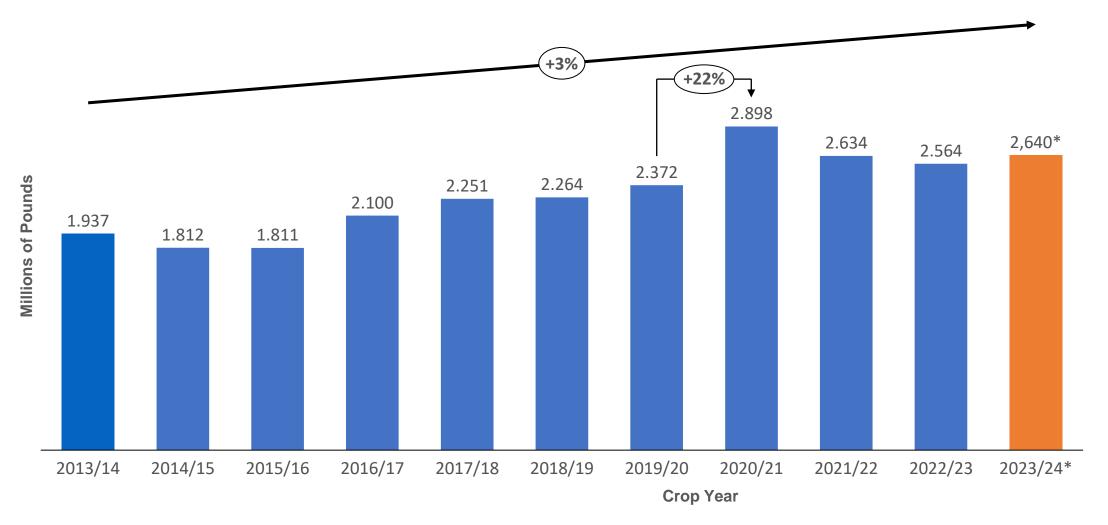
California Almond Receipts Driving Supply Increase



California Bearing Acres Have Plateaued



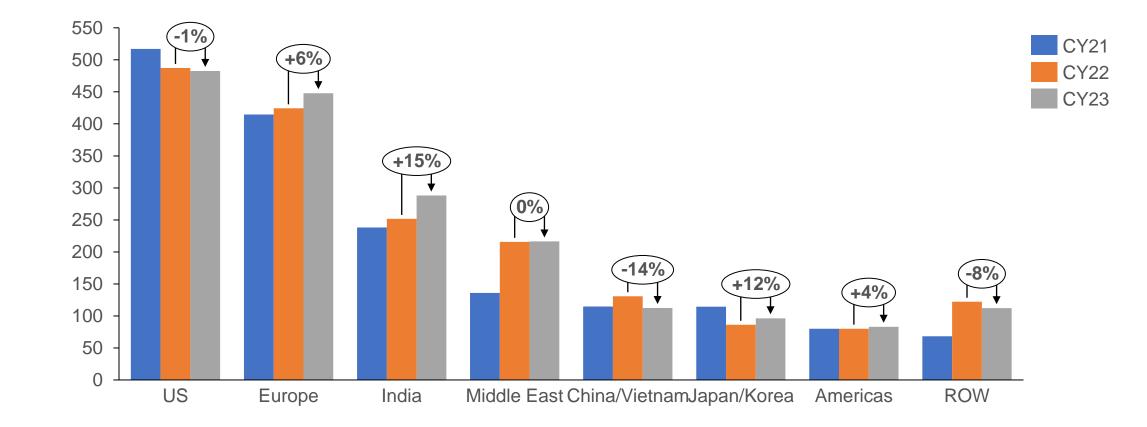
California Almond Crop Shipments Lag Increased Supply



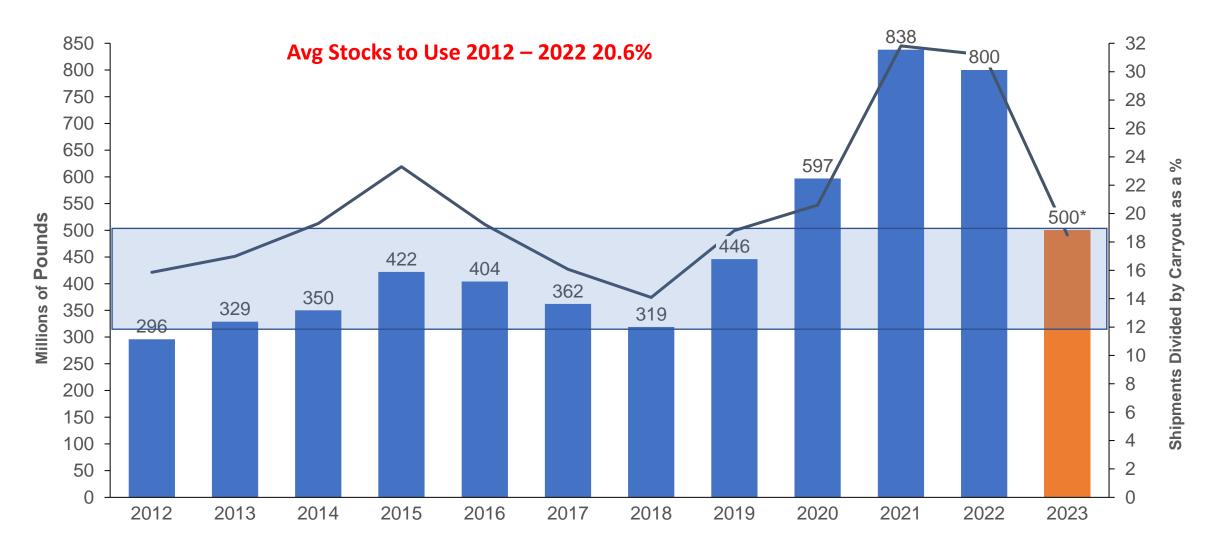
Regional Growth Off to a Strong Start

• CY23 YTD Shipments 2.3% ahead of prior year

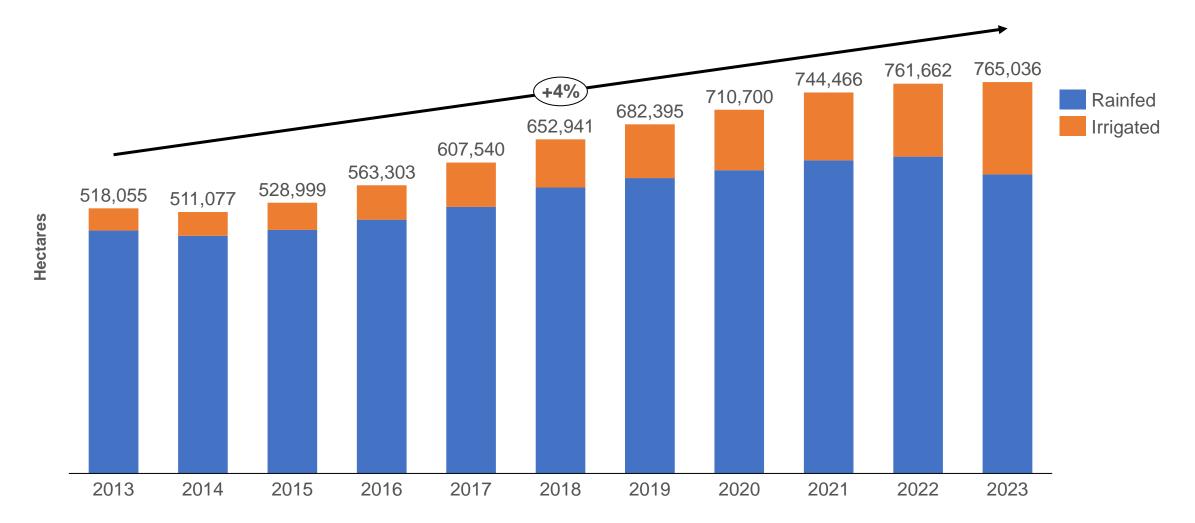


Carry-out Projection Normalizing After Two Short Crops

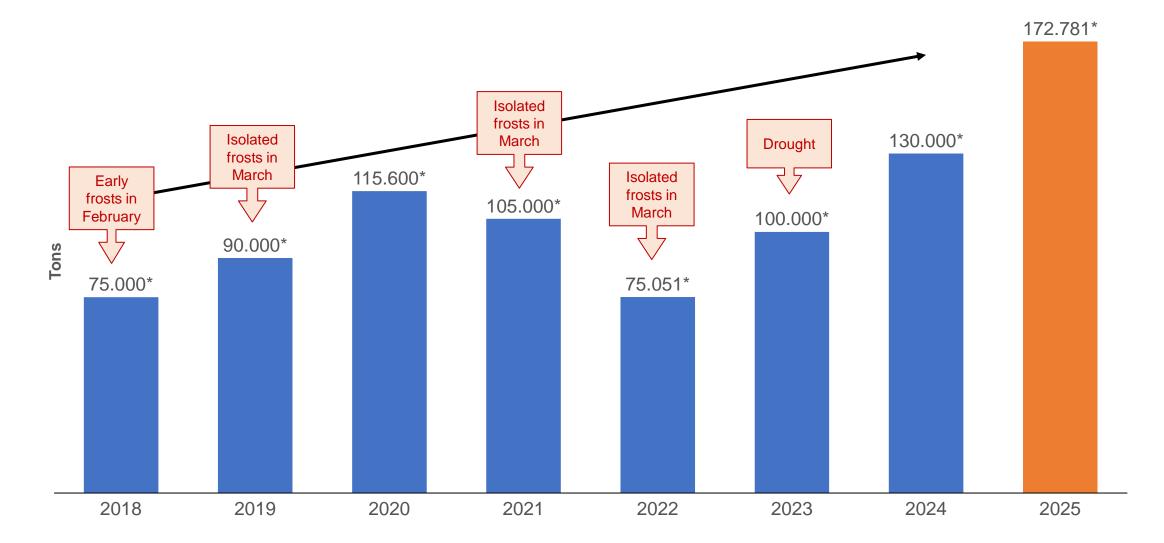

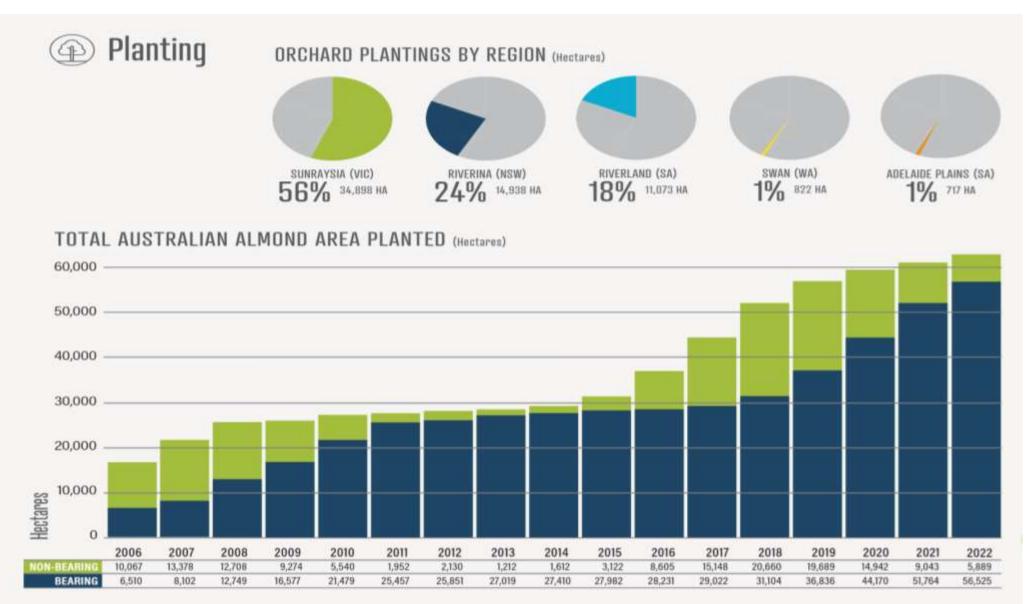
Spanish Almond Hectares are Flattening Out, Irrigated Increasing



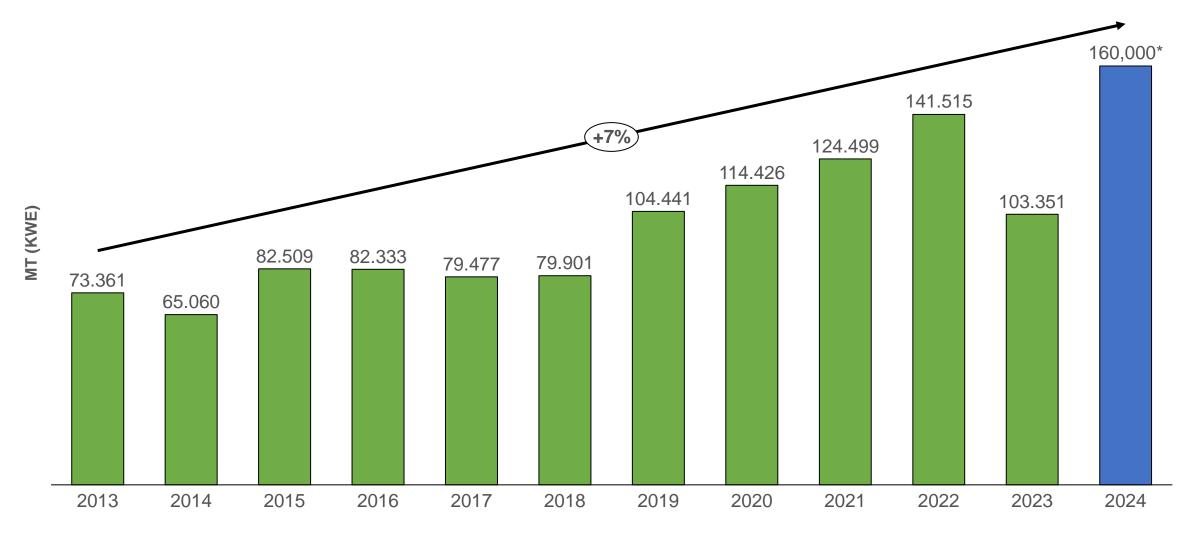
Spanish Almond Crop Production Impacted By Water and Weather
